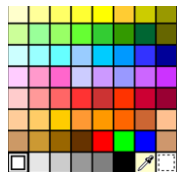

Thank you to everyone who gave their comments and views about the soundbeam workshop. These views have been forwarded to Kev at Banchory Day services.

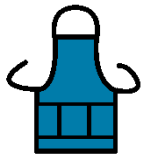

3 people have been passed to Gordon and Jane.

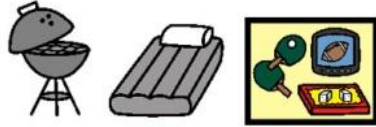
